<i>Substantive issue:</i>	Risk of torture upon deportation to the Islamic Republic of Iran

At its meeting on 6 November 2017, the Committee, having ascertained that the complainant had been granted refugee status and a three-year residence permit in Sweden on 11 August 2017 and was therefore no longer at risk of being forcibly removed to the Islamic Republic of Iran, decided to discontinue the consideration of communication No. 663/2015.
