I, **Judge NIL Nonn**, President of the Trial Chamber of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia (“ECCC”);

**BEING SEISED** of Case File No. 001/18-07-2007-ECCC/TC pursuant to the “Decision on Appeal against the Closing Order Indicting KAING Guek Eav Alias Duch,” rendered orally by the Pre-Trial Chamber on 5 December 2008 and filed in Khmer on 9 December 2008<sup>1</sup>;

**NOTING** the “Direction on the Scheduling of the Trial” dated 20 March 2009<sup>2</sup>;

**NOTING** the “Order Scheduling the Trial Proceedings for the Period of 20 to 30 April 2009”, dated 10 April 2009<sup>3</sup>;

**NOTING** the “Order Scheduling the Trial Proceedings for the period of 18 May to 25 June 2009”, dated 30 April 2009<sup>4</sup>;

**RECALLING** that the Trial Chamber issued an oral decision concerning the scheduling of the trial for the period of 30 June to 14 July during the hearing of 22 June 2009<sup>5</sup>;

**NOTING** the “Order Scheduling Sitting Days for the Next Three Months (6 July to 1 October 2009)”, dated 12 June 2009<sup>6</sup>;

**NOTING** the “Decision on Protective Measures for Witnesses and Experts and on Parties’ Requests to Hear Witnesses and Experts”, dated 3 April 2009<sup>7</sup>;

**NOTING** the “Decision on Protective Measures for Civil Parties”, dated 02 June 2009<sup>8</sup>;

**MINDFUL** of the need to provide the Parties with sufficient notice of the future scheduling of the trial proceedings, including an indication of when witnesses and experts will be called to testify;

**ORDER** that the schedule of the Substantive Hearing for the period of Monday 13 July 2009 to Wednesday 26 August 2009 will be as follows:

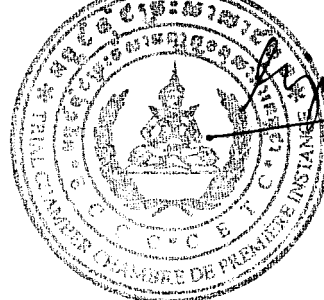
- From 13 to 16 July 2009: Hearing of the testimony of witnesses KW-08 and KW-09 relating to M-13, Armed Conflict and the Functioning of S21 including Cheung Ek;
- From 20 to 22 July 2009: Hearing of the testimony of witnesses KW-10, KW-11 and KW-07 relating to the Functioning of S-21 including Cheung Ek;
- On 27 and 28 July 2009: Hearing of the testimony of witnesses KW-15 and KW-20 relating to the Functioning of S-21 including Cheung Ek;
- From 3 to 6 August 2009: Hearing of the testimony of witnesses KW-21, KW-22, KW-23 and expert David Chandler relating to the Functioning of S-21 including Cheung Ek;
- On 10 August 2009: Hearing of survivors KW-28 and KW-29 on the functioning of S-24;
- From 11 to 26 August 2009: Hearing of expert CP2/5 and the following Civil Parties on the reparation claimed: Hav Sophea (D25/4), Neth Phally (E2/50), Robert Hamill (E2/87), Jeffrey James (E2/86), Phung Guth Sunthary (D25/5), Im Sunthy (D25/7), Chum Sirath (D25/6), Chhin Navy (D25/2), Keang Vannary (E2/77), Seang Vandy (D25/13), Ros Men (D25/9), Touch Monin (D25/14), Chum Neou (D25/16), E2/34, E2/81, D25/27, E2/82, E2/85, E2/89, Ou Savrith (E2/26).
