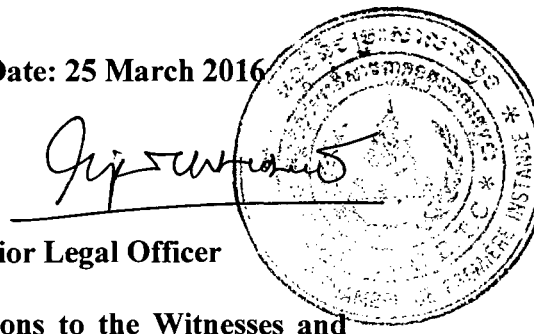

SUBJECT: Decision on National Co-Prosecutor's Objections to the Witnesses and Experts Proposed by the Other Parties



1. The Trial Chamber is seised of the National Co-Prosecutor's Objections to the Witnesses and Experts Proposed by the Other Parties (E305/10). The National Co-Prosecutor objects to witnesses 2-TCW-831, 2-TCW-951 and CHEA Sim (2-TCW-878) proposed by the NUON Chea Defence Team on the grounds that the latter has failed to justify the need to call these proposed witnesses and the witness's testimony would be repetitious and unnecessarily prolong the proceedings. The National Co-Prosecutor further submits that, should the Trial Chamber consider that the evidence from these three witnesses is indispensable, the submission of written testimonies in lieu of their personal appearance could be requested (E305/10, para. 3).
2. The Trial Chamber recalls that it has deferred a decision on the request to hear witnesses 2-TWC-831 and 2-TCW-951 to the appropriate later stages of the proceedings (See E370/3).
3. With regard to witness CHEA Sim (2-TCW-878), the Chamber notes that he passed away on 8 June 2015 (Saing Soenthrith, "CPP President Chea Sim dead", *Cambodia Daily*, 8 June 2015, at <https://www.cambodiadaily.com/archives/cpp-president-chea-sim-dead-85182/>). The National Co-Prosecutor's objections and submissions with respect to this witness are therefore moot.
4. This constitutes the Chamber's official response to E305/10.
