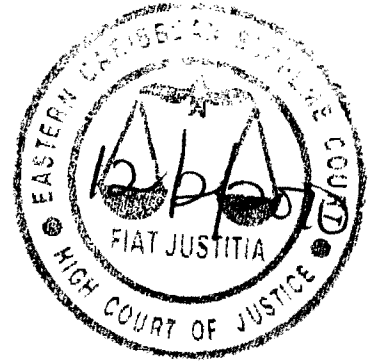

Reason for decision

UPON the application by the Defendant for an order setting aside the Default Judgment in this matter coming on for hearing on 17th March 2008; AND the Court considering the evidence filed, the draft judgment, and the submissions of counsel for the respective parties; AND UPON HEARING counsel for the parties; AND THE COURT being satisfied that the Defendant had satisfied the conditions set forth in CPR13.3;

THE COURT ORDERED that the Default judgment entered on 13th February 2007 be and the same was set aside with costs to the Claimant in the sum of \$500.00.

The court further ordered the Defendant to file and serve his Defence to the Claimant's claim within 7 days of the date of the order.
