

DECISION TO STRIKE OUT

Ekrem HAMIDOVIĆ

against

Bosnia and Herzegovina

The Human Rights Chamber for Bosnia and Herzegovina, sitting as the Second Panel on 9 December 2000 with the following members present:

Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement ("the Agreement") set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(2)(c) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber's Rules of Procedure:

I INTRODUCTION

1. The application was introduced on 2 August 1999.

2. The case concerns the applicant's attempts to obtain a pension to a certain amount.

3. On 16 November 2000 the applicant submitted a written statement by which he withdrew the application pending before the Chamber, as he had realised his rights to his satisfaction.

II OPINION OF THE CHAMBER

4. Having regard to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, the Chamber finds that the applicant does not intend to pursue the application. Furthermore, the Chamber finds no special circumstances regarding respect for human rights which require the examination of the application to be continued. It follows that the application must be struck out of the list.

III CONCLUSION

5. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously,

STRIKES THE APPLICATION OUT.
