



## **DECISION ON ADMISSIBILITY**

Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement ("the Agreement") set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(2)(c) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber's Rules of Procedure:

**I. INTRODUCTION**

1. The application was introduced on 22 December 2000. The applicant complains that he is being unlawfully prevented from converting an attic space in the building where he lives in Sarajevo into an apartment. He had started this construction, without a building license, when the competent authorities ordered him, under threat of execution, to restore the attic space to its original state.
2. The applicant requested that the Chamber order the respondent Party, as a provisional measure, to refrain from all actions which would restore the attic space to its original state before the proceedings before the Chamber are concluded.

**II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER**

3. The Chamber notes that the applicant started to construct the apartment without having first secured the building licence. In light of all the material in its possession, the Chamber finds that the application does not disclose any appearance of a violation of the rights and freedoms guaranteed under the Agreement. It follows that the application must be rejected, in accordance with Article VIII(2)(c) of the Agreement as manifestly ill-founded.

**III. CONCLUSION**

4. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously,

**DECLARES THE APPLICATION INADMISSIBLE.**
