



DECISION ON ADMISSIBILITY

Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement (“the Agreement”) set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(2)(c) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber’s Rules of Procedure:

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The application was introduced on 7 June 2001. The applicant requested the Chamber to order the respondent Party, as a provisional measure, to take all necessary action to prevent his eviction from the house he temporarily occupies in Sarajevo, Ulica Julija Vareska 36, until he may return to his house in Višegrad – Republika Srpska which has been totally destroyed. The Chamber rejected this request on 14 June 2001.
2. The applicant complains of his eviction from the house he temporarily occupies in Sarajevo.

II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER

3. The Chamber notes that the decision of the Municipal Service for Urbanism, Housing and Utility Affairs of the Municipality Novi Grad – Sarajevo, by which the applicant was ordered to vacate the apartment, was taken to allow the owner of the house in question to repossess it and that the applicant was provided with alternative accommodation. The Chamber finds that the application does not disclose any appearance of a violation of the rights and freedoms guaranteed under the Agreement. It follows that the application must be rejected, in accordance with Article VIII(2)(c) of the Agreement, as manifestly ill-founded.

III. CONCLUSION

4. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously,

DECLARES THE APPLICATION INADMISSIBLE.
