Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement ("the Agreement") set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber's Rules of Procedure:

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The application was introduced on 9 May 2001. The applicant requested the Chamber to order the respondent Parties, as a provisional measure, to take all necessary action to prevent her eviction. On 11 May 2001 the Chamber ordered the provisional measure requested. The respondent Parties complied with the order.
2. On 25 June 2001 the applicant informed the Chamber in writing that she had been allocated another accommodation. In addition, the applicant stated that she decided to withdraw her application.

II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER

3. Having regard to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, the Chamber finds that the applicant does not intend to pursue the application. Furthermore, the Chamber finds no special circumstances regarding respect for human rights which require the examination of the application to be continued. It follows that the application may be struck out of the list.
4. The Chamber will withdraw its order for a provisional measure with immediate effect.

III. CONCLUSION

5. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously,

STRIKES THE APPLICATION OUT and

WITHDRAWS ITS ORDER FOR A PROVISIONAL MEASURE WITH IMMEDIATE EFFECT.
