



## **DECISION TO STRIKE OUT**

Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement ("the Agreement") set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(3)(a) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber's Rules of Procedure:

## **I INTRODUCTION**

1. The application was introduced on 26 January 1998.
2. The applicant complained of her inability to be registered as owner over the apartment located at ulica Maršala Tita 62 in Tuzla. The applicant purchased the apartment from SFRY – SSNO, Military Civil Engineering Office in Sarajevo, on the basis of a purchase contract of 4 April 1992.
3. On 15 June 2001 the applicant informed the Chamber that her case regarding purchase of her apartment had been resolved in her favour and that she, accordingly, does not wish to pursue her application before the Chamber.

## **II OPINION OF THE CHAMBER**

4. In accordance with Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, “the Chamber may decide at any point in its proceedings to suspend consideration of, reject or strike out, an application on the ground that (a) the applicant does not intend to pursue his application; ... provided that such result is consistent with the objective of respect for human rights.”
5. The Chamber finds that the applicant does not wish to pursue her application. Furthermore, the Chamber finds no special circumstances regarding respect for human rights which require the examination of the application to be continued. The Chamber, therefore, finds it appropriate to strike out the application.

## **III. CONCLUSION**

6. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously,

**STRIKES THE APPLICATION OUT.**
