Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement ("the Agreement") set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(3)(b) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber's Rules of Procedure:

I. INTRODUCTION

- 1. The application was introduced on 28 June 2000. The applicant complained of the Procedural Decision of the Petty Offence Court in Municipality Novi Grad Sarajevo dated 28 December 1999 by which she was assessed a fine of 150 KM.
- 2. In the applicant's letter submitted on 6 September 2001, the applicant informed the Chamber that she wished to withdraw the application.

II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER

- 3. In accordance with Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, "the Chamber may decide at any point in its proceedings to suspend consideration of, reject or strike out, an application on the ground that ... (b) the matter has been resolved; ... provided that such a result is consistent with the objective of respect for human rights."
- 4. Having regard to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, the Chamber finds that the applicant wished to withdraw the application. The Chamber finds no special circumstances regarding respect for human rights which require the examination of the application to be continued. The Chamber therefore finds it appropriate to strike out the application.

III. CONCLUSION

5. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously,

STRIKES OUT THE APPLICATION.
