



DECISION TO STRIKE OUT

Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement ("the Agreement") set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(3)(b) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber's Rules of Procedure:

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The application was introduced on 24 April 2002.
2. The applicant complains of the non-enforcement of a procedural decision issued by the Ministry for Refugees and Displaced Persons in Banja Luka on 28 September 2001, confirming her right to regain possession of her apartment.
3. On 2 August 2002, the applicant informed the Chamber in writing that she had repossessed her apartment. The applicant suggested that the Chamber strike the application out of its list.

II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER

4. In accordance with Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, “the Chamber may decide at any point in its proceedings to suspend consideration of, reject or strike out, an application on the ground that ... (b) the matter has been resolved; ... provided that such a result is consistent with the objective of respect for human rights.”
5. Considering that the applicant has repossessed her apartment and that she has suggested that her application be struck out, the Chamber finds that the matter raised in the application has been resolved. Furthermore, the Chamber finds no special circumstances regarding respect for human rights which require the examination of the application to be continued. The Chamber therefore decides to strike out the application.

III. CONCLUSION

6. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously,

STRIKES OUT THE APPLICATION.
