Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement ("the Agreement") set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(3)(b) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber's Rules of Procedure:

### I. FACTS

- 1. The application was introduced on 17 August 1998.
- 2. The applicant complained of her inability to repossess her pre-war apartment, located at Nurije Pozderca no. 2/III, in Sarajevo.
- 3. On 23 July 2002 the Chamber sent a letter to the applicant asking if there had been any developments in her attempts to solve her housing problem since her last correspondence with the Chamber.
- 4. On 12 August 2002 the applicant confirmed that she had succeeded to enter into possession of the above-mentioned apartment and that as a result she withdraws her application.

### II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER

- 5. In accordance with Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, "the Chamber may decide at any point in its proceedings to suspend consideration of, reject or strike out, an application on the ground that ... (b) the matter has been resolved; ... provided that such a result is consistent with the objective of respect for human rights."
- 6. Considering the applicant's statement that she has entered into possession of her pre-war apartment, the Chamber finds that the matter raised in the application has been resolved. Furthermore, the Chamber finds no special circumstances regarding respect for human rights which require the examination of the application to be continued. The Chamber therefore decides to strike out the application.

## III. CONCLUSION

7. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously,

STRIKES OUT THE APPLICATION.
