

# DECISION TO STRIKE OUT

Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement ("the Agreement") set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(3)(a) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber's Rules of Procedure:

## CH/98/823

## I. INTRODUCTION

1. The application was introduced before the Chamber on 30 July 1998.
2. This case concerns the applicant's attempts to regain possession of her pre-war apartment, located at Kaptol 9, in Sarajevo.
3. On 24 January 2003, the applicant informed the Chamber that she had been reinstated into possession of her apartment and that she therefore did not wish to pursue the proceedings before the Chamber.

## II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER

4. In accordance with Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, "the Chamber may decide at any point in its proceedings to suspend consideration of, reject or strike out, an application on the ground that (a) the applicant does not intend to pursue his application; ... provided that such result is consistent with the objective of respect for human rights."
5. The Chamber notes that the applicant has informed it that she does not intend to pursue her application. Furthermore, the Chamber finds no special circumstances regarding respect for human rights which require the examination of the application to be continued. The Chamber therefore decides to strike out the application.

## III. CONCLUSION

6. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously,
