Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement (“the Agreement”) set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement as well as Rule 52 of the Chamber’s Rules of Procedure:

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The application was introduced on 4 December 2000. The applicant complained that the respondent Party enacted certain legislation which restricts the applicant's free access to and use of money she deposited into a bank savings account in "Jugobanka", Branch Office Sarajevo . On 11 January 2001 the applicant wrote to say that she was withdrawing her application.

II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER

2. Having regard to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, the Chamber finds that the applicant does not intend to pursue the application. Furthermore, although the applicant does not explain her reasons for withdrawal of her application, the Chamber cannot find any special circumstances regarding respect for human rights which require the examination of the application to be continued. It follows that the application must be struck out of the list.

III. CONCLUSION

For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously,
