



## **DECISION TO STRIKE OUT**

Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement (“the Agreement”) set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber’s Rules of Procedure:

**I. INTRODUCTION**

1. The application was introduced on 29 June 2000. The applicant requested the Chamber to order the respondent Party as a provisional measure to take all necessary action to prevent his eviction. On 5 July 2000, the Chamber decided not to order the provisional measure requested.
2. The applicant complained of being ordered to vacate an apartment he occupied on a temporary basis, although he had not been enabled to repossess his pre-war apartment.
3. On 29 January 2001 the applicant informed the Chamber in writing that he had repossessed his pre-war apartment in Zenica and did not intend to pursue the application.

**II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER**

4. Having regard to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, the Chamber finds that the matter raised in the application has been resolved. Furthermore, the Chamber finds no special circumstances regarding respect for human rights which require the examination of the application to be continued. It follows that the application must be struck out of the list.

**III. CONCLUSION**
