



DECISION TO STRIKE OUT

Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement ("the Agreement") set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber's Rules of Procedure:

I INTRODUCTION

1. The application was introduced on 21 August 2000.
2. The applicant complained of his inability to return to his pre-war apartment located at Ulica Šekerova 44/II in Sarajevo.
3. The application was transmitted to the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina ("the Federation") on 22 June 2001. On 23 July 2001 the Federation submitted its observations, stating that the applicant had regained possession of the apartment in question on 22 May 2001.
4. On 16 July 2001 the applicant informed the Chamber that he had been reinstated into his apartment on 22 May 2001.

II OPINION OF THE CHAMBER

5. In accordance with Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, "the Chamber may decide at any point in its proceedings to suspend consideration of, reject or strike out, an application on the ground that ... (b) the matter has been resolved; ... provided that such result is consistent with the objective of respect for human rights."
6. Considering that the applicant has been reinstated into his apartment, the Chamber finds that the matter has been resolved. Furthermore, the Chamber finds no special circumstances regarding respect for human rights which require the examination of the application to be continued. The Chamber therefore finds it appropriate to strike the application out.

III CONCLUSION

7. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously,

STRIKES THE APPLICATION OUT.
