



## **DECISION ON ADMISSIBILITY**

Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement ("the Agreement") set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(2)(c) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber's Rules of Procedure:

**I. INTRODUCTION**

1. The application was introduced on 9 October 2000 and registered on 10 October 2000. The applicant requested the Chamber to order a provisional measure to take all necessary action to prevent her eviction. On 10 November 2000 the Chamber decided not to order the provisional measure requested.

2. The applicant complains of a decision of the Municipality Zenica confirming the occupancy right of the pre-war occupant to regain possession of the apartment currently occupied by the applicant at ul. Armije BiH 22 in Zenica.

**II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER**

3. The Chamber notes that the decision of the Municipality Zenica was taken to allow the pre-war occupancy right holder to repossess the apartment and that the applicant has no legal right to occupy the apartment. In these circumstances and in the light of all the material in its possession, the Chamber finds that the application does not disclose any appearance of a violation of the rights and freedoms guaranteed under the Agreement. It follows that the application must be rejected as manifestly ill-founded, in accordance with Article VIII(2)(c) of the Agreement.

**III. CONCLUSION**

4. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously
