Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement ("the Agreement") set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement and Rule 52 of the Chamber's Rules of Procedure:

**I. INTRODUCTION**

1. The application was introduced on 28 November 2000. The applicant requested that the Chamber order a provisional measure to take all necessary action to prevent the removal or looting his possessions from his pre-war apartment in the by the person there occupying that apartment. On 9 January 2001, the Chamber decided not to order the provisional measure requested.
2. The applicant's sole purpose in applying to the Chamber was to obtain an order for a provisional measure as set out above.

**II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER**

3. As the Chamber has decided to reject the request for provisional measures and as there is no other issue to be decided, the Chamber finds that the case must be struck out in accordance with Article VIII(3) of the Agreement.

**III. CONCLUSION**
