Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement ("the Agreement") set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(2)(c) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber's Rules of Procedure:

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The application was introduced on 4 April 2001 and registered on the same day. The applicant requested that the Chamber order to the respondent Party as a provisional measure to take all necessary action to prevent his eviction from an apartment which uses. On 5 April 2001, the Chamber decided not to order the provisional measure requested.
2. The applicant complains of a decision of the Ministry for Refugees and Displaced Persons in Gradiška dated 5 April 2000, ordering his eviction from an apartment which he occupies.

II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER

3. The Chamber notes that the decision in question was taken to allow the pre-war holder of the occupancy right to repossess the apartment and that the applicant has no legal right to occupy the apartment. In these circumstances and in the light of all the material in its possession, the Chamber finds that the application does not disclose any appearance of a violation of the rights and freedoms guaranteed under the Agreement. It follows that the application must be rejected as manifestly ill-founded, in accordance with Article VIII(2)(c) of the Agreement.

III. CONCLUSION

4. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously

DECLARES THE APPLICATION INADMISSIBLE.
