Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement (“the Agreement”) set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(2)(c) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber’s Rules of Procedure:

I INTRODUCTION

1. The application was introduced on 3 April 2001. The applicant requested that the Chamber order the respondent Party, as a provisional measure, to take all necessary action to prevent his eviction from an apartment in Sarajevo. On 6 April 2001 the Chamber decided not to order the provisional measure requested.

2. The applicant complains of a decision of the Administration for Housing Affairs of Canton Sarajevo ordering his eviction from the apartment located in Sarajevo, Grada Kalgarija 12/IV, which he occupies. The Administration decided *ex officio* that the applicant should be evicted because he was using the apartment without a legal basis.

II OPINION OF THE CHAMBER

3. The Chamber notes that the applicant was ordered to vacate the apartment on the ground that he had no legal right to occupy it. In light of all the material in its possession, the Chamber finds that the facts complained of do not disclose any appearance of a violation of the rights and freedoms guaranteed under the Agreement. It follows that the application is manifestly ill-founded within the meaning of Article VIII(2)(c) of the Agreement.

III CONCLUSION

4. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously,

DECLARES THE APPLICATION INADMISSIBLE.
