Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement (“the Agreement”) set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(3)(a) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber’s Rules of Procedure:

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The application was introduced on 12 April 2002. The application concerns the applicant's allegation that the respondent Party denies him a decent life by giving him a minimum pension of only 140 KM per month. The application was not transmitted to the respondent Party for its observations. On 20 September 2002, the applicant informed the Chamber that he wanted to withdraw the application.

II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER

2. In accordance with Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, "the Chamber may decide at any point in its proceedings to suspend consideration of, reject or strike out, an application on the ground that (a) the applicant does not intend to pursue his application; ... provided that such a result is consistent with the objective of respect for human rights."

3. Considering that the applicant wishes to withdraw his application, the Chamber finds no special circumstances regarding respect for human rights which require the examination of the application to be continued. The Chamber therefore decides to strike out the application, pursuant to Article VIII(3)(a) of the Agreement.

III. CONCLUSION

4. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously,

STRIKES OUT THE APPLICATION.
