Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement ("the Agreement") set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber's Rules of Procedure:

I. FACTS

1. The application was introduced on 26 January 1998.
2. The case concerns the attempts of the applicant to register his ownership over the apartment located at Aleja bosanskih vladara 22 in Tuzla.
3. On 25 January 2001 the applicant submitted a statement that he no longer wishes to proceed with his application before the Chamber, as he has succeeded in registering his ownership rights over his property with the Land Registry in the Municipal Court in Tuzla.

II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER

4. Having regard to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, the Chamber finds that the applicant does not intend to pursue his application. Furthermore, the Chamber finds no special circumstances regarding respect for human rights which require the examination of the application to be continued. It follows that the application is to be struck out of the list.

III. CONCLUSION

5. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously,

STRIKES OUT THE APPLICATION.
