Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement (“the Agreement”) set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(2)(c) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber’s Rules of Procedure:

I INTRODUCTION

1. The application was introduced on 16 July 1998.
2. The case concerns the attempts of the applicant to regain possession of an apartment located at Ulica Albina Herljevića no. 37/3 in Tuzla.
3. On 4 January 2000 the respondent Party informed the Chamber that the applicant had repossessed the apartment on 20 September 1999. On 12 June 2001 the applicant informed the Chamber that her case had been resolved.

II OPINION OF THE CHAMBER

4. Having regard to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, the Chamber finds that the matter raised in the application has been resolved. Furthermore, the Chamber finds no special circumstances regarding respect for human rights which require the examination of the application to be continued. It follows that the application may be struck out of the list.

III CONCLUSION

5. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously,

STRIKES THE APPLICATION OUT.
