Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement (“the Agreement”) set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(3)(a) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber’s Rules of Procedure:

I. INTRODUCTION

1. The application was introduced on 21 July 1998.
2. The applicant complained of her inability to repossess her pre-war apartment, located at Topal Osman Paše no. 7, in Sarajevo.
3. On 9 May 2002 the applicant informed the Chamber that she had succeeded to enter into the possession of the above mentioned apartment and that she would like to withdraw her application.

II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER

4. In accordance with Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, “the Chamber may decide at any point in its proceedings to suspend consideration of, reject or strike out, an application on the ground that (a) the applicant does not intend to pursue her application;...provided that such result is consistent with objective of respect for human rights”.
5. The Chamber finds that the applicant does not wish to pursue her application. Furthermore, the Chamber finds no special circumstances regarding respect for human rights which require the examination of the application to be continued. The Chamber, therefore, finds it appropriate to strike out the application.

III. CONCLUSION

6. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously,

STRIKES THE APPLICATION OUT.
