Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement ("the Agreement") set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber's Rules of Procedure:

**I. INTRODUCTION**

1. The application was introduced on 16 June 1999.
2. The applicant complains that the Municipal Sector for Urbanism, Geodetic and Property-Legal Affairs in Bihać did not enforce its decision of 1 June 1998 ordering the applicant's repossession of a house in Ulica 29. Novembra 50.
3. On 23 August 2000 the applicant informed the Chamber in writing that he did not intend to pursue the application since he had succeeded in repossessing the above house.

**II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER**

4. Having regard to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, the Chamber finds that the applicant does not intend to pursue the application. Furthermore, the Chamber finds no special circumstances regarding respect for human rights which require the examination of the application to be continued. It follows that the application must be struck out of the list.

**III. CONCLUSION**
