Having considered the aforementioned application introduced pursuant to Article VIII(1) of the Human Rights Agreement (“the Agreement”) set out in Annex 6 to the General Framework Agreement for Peace in Bosnia and Herzegovina;

Adopts the following decision pursuant to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement and Rules 49(2) and 52 of the Chamber’s Rules of Procedure:

I INTRODUCTION

1. The application was introduced to the Chamber on 28 June 1999 and registered on 30 June 1999.
2. The applicant complains of his inability to return to his pre-war apartment located at Ulica Kevrin potok 1/pr. (formerly Ahmeta Fetahagića 1/pr.) in Sarajevo. On 8 May 2001 the applicant's representative informed the Chamber that the applicant had been reinstated into the apartment and therefore wished to withdraw his application.

II. OPINION OF THE CHAMBER

3. Having regard to Article VIII(3) of the Agreement, the Chamber finds that the matter raised in the application has been resolved. Furthermore, the Chamber finds no special circumstances regarding respect for human rights which require the examination of the application to be continued. It follows that the application may be struck out of the list.

III. CONCLUSION

4. For these reasons, the Chamber, unanimously,

STRIKES THE APPLICATION OUT.
