[1] 1854, of July 25, 1974, on the arrest of Hugo Anselmo Chacaltana Silva, a minor, a denunciation transmitted to the Government of Chile on July 29, 1974. In this note of July 31, 1974 (No. 12847), the Government of Chile provided the following information:

"I refer to your note of July 29, 1974, through which the Inter-American Commission of Human Rights recommends to the Government of Chile that it release or move Hugo Anselmo Chacaltana Silva, because he is a minor.

"In this regard and as I informed the Secretary of the Commission when he visited "Tres Alamos", Chacaltana was released on July 29, 1974."

[2] The Commission examined this case during its thirty-fifth session (May 1975), together with the information provided by the Government of Chile. It decided to file the case without further processing.
