[1] 1906, of February 12, 1975, denounces the arbitrary arrest of Mr. Jose Esteban Gonzalez, a Christina social leader.

[2] In a letter dated February 13, 1975, the Secretariat acknowledged receipt to the claimant and requested that the claimant provide additional information.

[3] The Commission considered this during the course of its thirty-sixth session (May 1975); and in view of the fact that the claimant had not provided additional information to supplement the complaint, it decided to file the case without prejudice to reopening the file should additional information be provided within a reasonable period of time.
