HAVING SEEN the content of reports Nos. 49/90, 50/90, 51/90, 52/90, 53/90, 54/90, 55/90, 56/90, 57/90, 58/90, 59/90, 60/90, 61/90, 62/90, 63/90, 64/90, 65/90, 66/90, 67/90, 68/90, 69/90, 70/90, 71/90, and 72/90 which set a deadline for the Government of Guatemala to carry out the recommendations made in each of those reports and to settle the respective case or formulate observations, upon expiration of

which deadline the Commission would proceed in accordance with Article 48 of its Regulations and so include said reports in its Annual Report, and

CONSIDERING:

1. That the Government of Guatemala has neither carried out the Commission's recommendations in each case nor settled them in the terms proposed;
2. That The Government of Guatemala has neither presented observations on those reports nor replied to the communications that the Commission has sent in this regard; and,
That the Commission has not received any new information that would require it to modify said reports.

To publish the aforementioned reports in its Annual Report of 1990-1991.
