48. On March 6, 1998, the Commission requested that the State of Peru adopt precautionary measures on behalf of Baruch Ivcher, whose case N° 11.762 is before the Commission. The Commission requested that, while Mr. Ivcher's case is pending the decision of the Commission, the State refrain from taking or executing any action or measure that would worsen his situation, including ordering his capture by Interpol.
