On April 1, 1998, the Commission requested the adoption of precautionary measures on behalf of Trevor Fisher (case 11.643), who has been sentenced to death and whose execution was scheduled for April 2, 1998. The Commission requested that the State of The Bahamas grant Fisher a stay of execution until a decision was reached on the merits of the case.
