On August 14, 1998, the Commission requested the adoption of precautionary measures on behalf of 120 Cuban detainees in The Bahamas, who had requested refugee status and were to be deported to Cuba. The Commission requested that the State of The Bahamas not deport these Cuban nationals until it was able to study in detail the human rights violations reported in their complaint before the Commission.
