On November 20, 1998, the Commission renewed its request of November 19, 1997 for precautionary measures on behalf of Peter Blaine, whose case 11.827 is pending before the Commission and who was sentenced to death and scheduled for execution on November 26, 1998. The Commission requested a stay of execution until a decision could be reached on the merits of the case.
