On March 3, 1999, the Commission requested precautionary measures on behalf of Patricia Ballestero Vidal, Lee Pope and Arnold Fuentes, of Spanish, United States and French nationality respectively, who, according to the information received, had been ordered expelled for having participated in and expressed their support and solidarity for a demonstration organized by the Pehuenches indigenous population on February 18, 1999 in the Alto Bio-Bio.
