On June 24, 1999, the Commission granted precautionary measures in favor of attorney Joaquín Marcelo Denadai, a human rights defender and a key witness in corruption cases, and on behalf of Public Prosecutor, José Luis Azevedo da Silveira, both of the State of Espírito Santo, on account of the serious death threats made against them by the para-military organization Scuderie Le Coq (this matter is being processed as case 12.003). This request was reiterated to the State on September 7, 1999. During the period of the present report, the parties continued presenting information and observations in relation to these measures.
