On August 27, 1999, the Commission granted precautionary measures on behalf of David Leisure, who was sentenced to death and scheduled to be executed in the state of Missouri on September 1, 1999, and whose case, 12.201, is pending before the Commission. The Commission requested a stay of execution in order to avoid irreparable harm to Mr. Leisure. The Commission did not receive a response to its request from the State, and Mr. Leisure was executed on September 1, 1999.
