On March 8, 2000, the Commission addressed the State for the purpose of requesting the adoption of precautionary measures to protect the life, physical integrity and liberty of Jairo Bedoya Hoyos, whose whereabouts were unknown since Thursday, March 2, 2000. Mr. Bedoya Hoyos, who had held diverse elected positions and worked in favor of human rights in marginalized, black and indigenous communities, had received threats prior to his disappearance from various actors within the armed conflict, especially the paramilitary groups of the zones of Antioquia and Chocó.
