On March 9, 2000, the Commission requested that precautionary measures be adopted on behalf of Catherine Halvey, a human rights defender with the Human Rights Center of the Archdiocese of Manaus, who informed the IACHR that she had received several death threats as a result of her activities. The State informed the Commission that it had taken precautionary measures; those measures expired on September 9, 2000.
