On July 17, 2000, the IACHR granted precautionary measures on behalf of Vilma Núñez de Escorcia for the Nicaraguan State to take the necessary steps to protect the life and physical integrity of Mrs. Núñez de Escorcia, a human rights defender, who had received a series of death threats. The parties continued to present information and observations in connection with these measures.
