On October 15, 2002 the IACHR granted precautionary measures on behalf of Maria Ramona Daza, Maria Presidia de Sivira, Llibeth Mendoza, Ingri Liliana Colmenares Mendoza, Ediarly Colmenares Mendoza, Doris Colmenares, Maria de Colmenares, José Gregorio Colmenares, Edgar Jovanny Colmenares, Dennys Colmenares, Mariela Mendoza Carvajal, Carlos Gilberto Mendoza Carvajal, Leydi Rodríguez, Walter Rodriguez Rodriguez, and Ligia de Agray, relatives of victims of the extermination groups operating in the state of Portuguesa. According to the request presented to the IACHR, between 1999 and 2002 over 100 persons were assassinated, allegedly by active personnel assigned to the Police Force of Portuguesa. The beneficiaries had become targets of these groups. The State did not present information regarding the adoption of the precautionary measures.
