On March 7, 2003, the Commission granted precautionary measures on behalf of Carlos Rosero, Jairo Castillo, Rosa Helena Gallón, Dolis Manuela Salazar, Daira Elsa Quiñones, Hernán Cortés, and José Santos Caicedo, all members of the human rights organization Proceso de Comunidades Negras (PCN). The information available indicates that the members of this organization have received threats against their lives and physical integrity. In view of the risk to which the beneficiaries of the measure are exposed, the IACHR asked the Colombian State to adopt measures to protect the life and physical integrity of the members of the PCN and to report on the actions taken to investigate the facts and put an end to the threats. The Commission has continued receiving information on the situation of the persons protected.
