On December 20, 2006, the IACHR granted precautionary measures in favor of Dina Metabel Meza Elvir, Robert Marín García Martínez, Claudia Dinora Mendoza, Carlos Alberto Hernández Martínez, and Mirtha Yanina Romero, members of ASJ (the Association for a Fairer Society). The available information states that members of ASJ have been subjected to threats against their lives and physical integrity, and that on December 4, 2006, their legal representative in several cases defending labour rights, Dionisio Díaz García, was murdered. In view of this background, the Commission requested that the Government of Honduras adopt the measures necessary to protect the life and physical integrity of the beneficiaries and report on steps taken to investigate judicially the events that have given rise to the precautionary measures. The IACHR is monitoring the beneficiaries' situation.
