On December 12, 2008, the IACHR granted precautionary measures for Gabriel Zambrano, Carlos Murillo, Danilo del Arca and Carminda Pérez, community leaders in the town of Villanueva, Department of Cortés. The request for precautionary measures alleges that the afore-named leaders are the targets of threats and attacks because of their activities to reclaim land. A number of community leaders from the area have allegedly been killed recently. The Commission asked the Honduran state to adopt the measures necessary to guarantee the life and physical integrity of the beneficiaries and to report the steps taken to conduct a judicial inquiry into the events that warrant enforcement of precautionary measures. The Commission continues to monitor the situation.
