**DECISION ON THE TRANSMISSION OF THE TRANSCRIPT OF THE  
IN CAMERA MEETING HELD ON 17 MARCH 2006**

**I, Judge Sylvia Steiner**, judge at the International Criminal Court (the “Court”);

**NOTING** the “Decision Convening an *In Camera* Meeting” (the “Decision”)<sup>1</sup>, issued by Judge Sylvia Steiner acting as single judge of Pre-Trial Chamber I on 16 March 2006, by which an *in camera* meeting was convened with the Prosecutor and the Registrar, or their respective representatives, for Friday 17 March 2006 to deal with (i) the Prosecution’s request to unseal the arrest warrant against Mr Thomas Lubanga Dyilo; (ii) issues relating to the current classification of non-public documents in the record of the case against Mr Thomas Lubanga Dyilo; and (iii) issues relating to the current classification of certain non-public documents in the record of the situation in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (the “DRC”)<sup>2</sup>;

**NOTING** the *in camera* meeting held before the single judge in the case against Mr Thomas Lubanga Dyilo on 17 March 2006 (the “*In Camera* Meeting”) with the Prosecution and the Registrar pursuant to the Decision;

**NOTING** the “Decision Concerning the Transcripts of *In Camera* Meeting held on 17 March 2006”<sup>3</sup>, issued by Judge Sylvia Steiner acting as single judge of Pre-Trial Chamber I, by which the Prosecution was requested to (i) state whether any redaction is needed in the French version of the transcripts of the *In Camera* Meeting so that it may be made available to the Defence; and (ii) if necessary, to propose, by Wednesday 25 April 2006 at 14.00 hours, a redacted version of the French version of the transcripts which, in its view, can be made available to the Defence<sup>4</sup>;

**NOTING** the “Submission of the Proposed Redacted Transcript of the *in camera* Meeting of 17 March 2006” (the “Prosecution’s Submission”)<sup>5</sup>

**NOTING** the decision of Pre-Trial Chamber I of 22 March 2006 designating Judge Sylvia Steiner as single judge in the case against Mr Thomas Lubanga Dyilo responsible, under article 57 (2) of the Rome Statute (the “Statute”)<sup>6</sup>, for exercising the functions of the Chamber in that case, including those functions provided for in rule 121 (2) (b) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the “Rules”)<sup>7</sup>;

**NOTING** articles 57 (3) (c), 67 (1) and 68 (1) of the Statute and rules 87 and 88 of the Rules;

**CONSIDERING** that, in the framework of the *In Camera* Meeting, the single judge ruled that the transcripts of the meeting would be classified *ex parte* only available to the Prosecution and that the Prosecution would be consulted as to whether they could also be released to the Defence with or without redactions<sup>8</sup>;

**CONSIDERING** that the Prosecution does not oppose, in the Prosecution’s Submission, the release to the Defence of a redacted version of the transcripts of the *In Camera* Meeting;

**CONSIDERING** that there is no reason to prevent the release of the transcripts of the *In Camera* Meeting to the Defence as long as the necessary redactions are made;


**FOR THESE REASONS**

**INSTRUCT** the Registrar to proceed with the redactions of the French version of the transcripts of the *In Camera* Meeting as shown in the list of redactions filed confidential, *ex parte* only available to the Prosecution and annexed to the present decision;

**ORDER** the Registrar to classify the French redacted version of the transcripts of the *In Camera* Meeting as confidential;

**ORDER** the Registrar to notify, as soon as practicable, Mr Thomas Lubanga Dyilo and his Counsel of the French redacted version of the transcripts of the *In Camera* Meeting.
