**NOTING** the "Prosecution's Application pursuant to Rules 81 (2) and 81 (4)" ("the Prosecution Second Request"),<sup>2</sup> filed by the Prosecution on 23 August 2006;

**NOTING** the "Decision on the Prosecution practice to provide to the Defence redacted versions of evidence and materials without authorization by the Chamber", issued by the single judge on 25 August 2006<sup>3</sup>;

**NOTING** the "Final Decision on the E-Court Protocol for the Provision of Evidence, Material and Witness Information on Electronic Version for their Presentation During the Confirmation Hearing" ("Final Decision on the E-Court Protocol") issued by the single judge on 28 August 2006<sup>4</sup>;

**NOTING** the "Submission of the Document Containing the Charges pursuant to Article 61 (3) (a) and of the List of Evidence pursuant to Rule 121 (3)",<sup>5</sup> filed by the Prosecution on 28 August 2006, which included the Prosecution Charging Document and List of Evidence

NOTING the "Prosecution's Request for Authorization of Redactions in Documents" ("the Prosecution Third Request"),<sup>6</sup> filed by the Prosecution on 28 August 2006;

NOTING the "Prosecution's Application pursuant to Rules 81 (2) and (4)" ("the Prosecution Fourth Request"),<sup>7</sup> filed by the Prosecution on 28 August 2006;

**NOTING** the "Prosecution's Request for Authorization of Redactions in Documents Previously Disclosed to the Defence" ("the Prosecution Fifth Request"),<sup>8</sup> filed by the Prosecution on 29 August 2006;

**NOTING** the "Prosecution Application pursuant to Rules 81 (2) and 81 (4)" ("the Prosecution Sixth Request"),<sup>9</sup> filed by the Prosecution on 30 August 2006, and the corrigendum to Annexes 1 to 5 of the Prosecution Sixth Request filed by the Prosecution on 31 August 2006;

**NOTING** the *ex parte* hearing with the Prosecution and the representatives of the Victims and Witnesses Unit held in closed session on 1 September 2006, whereby the single judge (i) ordered the Prosecution to re-file the annexes to the Prosecution First Request, the Prosecution Second Request, the Prosecution Third Request, the Prosecution Fourth Request and the Prosecution Sixth Request, and to address the questions posed and the concerns raised by the Chamber; and (ii) decided to postpone the ex parte hearing of 4 September 2006 and to fix a new date for such a hearing only after the Prosecution has complied, by 11 September 2006, with the order for re-filing;

**NOTING** the "Decision on the Prosecution Request for Extension of Time, Clarification and Provision of Information",<sup>10</sup> issued by the single judge on 1 September 2006. and the "Decision concerning the Prosecution's Requests for Redactions", issued by the single judge on 1 September 2006;<sup>11</sup>

**CONSIDERING** that the Status Conference to be held tomorrow is the appropriate forum to discuss the matters related to the disclosure procedures and to the implications of the above mentioned filings on the timetable set in the "Decision on the Postponement of the Confirmation Hearing and the Adjustment of the Timetable set in the Decision on the Final System of Disclosure ( "Decision on the Postponement of the Confirmation Hearing")<sup>12</sup>;

#### FOR THESE REASONS

**DECIDES** that the agenda of the Status Conference of 5 September 2006 shall be as follows:

(1) Update from the Defence and the Registry on the logistical issues related to defence access to the evidence included in the Prosecution Charging Document and List of Evidence;

(2) Update from the Defence and the Registry on the logistical issues related to Defence investigative activities and resources;

(3) Disclosure process and filing of evidence with the Registry; filings according to the E-Court Protocol;
