- 1. Following the status conference on 4 September 2007, the judges of the Trial Chamber issued on 5 September 2007 an order setting out the schedule for submissions and hearings regarding the subjects which require early determination in the preparation for the trial of Mr Thomas Lubanga Dyilo.¹
- 2. Dates for a hearing to deal with the second set of issues (namely the role of victims in the proceedings leading up to, and during, the trial; the procedures to be adopted for instructing expert witnesses; and the approach to be adopted to witness familiarisation and witness proofing) were set for 30-31 October, and 1-2 November 2007.
- 3. For practical reasons, the Trial Chamber will not be able to sit on 1 and 2 November 2007, and the hearing on these dates is therefore cancelled. Instead, the hearing will start on Monday 29 October at 14.00, and continue on 30 and 31 October at 10.00 as necessary.
