- 1. On 13 September 2007,<sup>1</sup> the former defence counsel of Mr Thomas Lubanga Dyilo, Mr Jean Flamme, filed the "Motion by former counsel for leave to file written corrigenda to oral arguments" ("motion"),<sup>2</sup> in which he requests leave to file a written corrigendum to his oral submissions on 9 November 2006.<sup>3</sup>
- 2. On 3 October 2006, the Prosecutor filed a "Prosecution's reply to motion for leave to file written corrigenda to oral arguments",<sup>4</sup> in which he requests the Trial Chamber to dismiss former counsel's motion arguing that the "Chamber is without jurisdiction to receive and rule on the motion".5
- 3. The oral submissions which are sought to be corrected were made by former counsel during the hearing on the confirmation of charges before Pre-Trial Chamber I. Therefore, the Trial Chamber is not competent to consider the motion and hereby dismisses it.
