On 24 October 2007, the defence filed a "Requête de la Défense aux fins d'obtention des transcriptions d'audience en simultané en langue française",¹ arguing that the fact that the transcript of hearings through the LiveNote program is always produced simultaneously as an English text regardless of the language spoken by counsel disadvantages the defence. The motion attaches an email exchange with the Registry in which it is indicated that for technical reasons, simultaneous provision of LiveNote in French is not possible.² The defence requests that the Chamber order LiveNote to be provided in French during the
