I, Sylvia Steiner, judge at the International Criminal Court ("the Court")

NOTING the "First Decision on the Prosecution Request for Authorization to Redact

Witnesses Statements" ("the First Decision on Redactions")1 by which the Chamber

partially granted the Prosecution's request for authorisation to redact information in

the interview notes and statements of witnesses 1, 3, 7, 8, 12, 13 and 14, and ordered

the Prosecution to disclose such interview notes and statements to the Defence by

12 December 2007;

NOTING the "Prosecution's Application for Leave to Appeal and Urgent

Application for Confined Variation of the First Decision on Redaction of Witnesses

Statements"² ("the Prosecution Request for Leave to Appeal") filed by the

Prosecution on 10 December 2007, by which the Prosecution requests that the Single

Judge (i) grant leave to appeal the issues pursuant to article 82(1)(d) of the Rome

Statute ("the Statute"); and (ii) authorize the Prosecution to provisionally maintain

the redactions concerning third innocent parties, the identities of the OTP and VWU

personnel present during the interviews of the relevant witnesses and the locations

where such interviews took place,3 in order not to render the Prosecution Leave to

Appeal moot;

NOTING article 82(1)(d) of the Statute, rule 155 of the Rules of Procedure and

Evidence, and regulation 65 of the Regulations of the Court ("the Regulations");

CONSIDERING that the deadline imposed to the Prosecution in the First Decision

on Redactions in relation to the authorised redacted versions of the interview notes

and statements of witnesses 1, 3, 7, 8, 12 13 and 14 is set for 12 December 2007; and

that the deadline provided for in regulation 65 of the Regulations for the Defence to

respond to the Prosecution's Request for Leave to Appeal will only expire on

14 December 2007;

CONSIDERING that the disclosure of the interview notes and statements of the

above-mentioned witnesses as decided by the Single Judge in the First Decision on

Redactions prior to a decision on the Prosecution's Request for Leave to Appeal shall

effectively preempt the subject of the Prosecution request;

CONSIDERING however that the disclosure of the said interview notes and

witnesses statements as requested in the Prosecution Request for Leave to Appeal

would allow the Defence to immediately start its preparation for the confirmation

hearing;

FOR THESE REASONS

DECIDE to authorize the Prosecution to provisionally maintain those redactions to

the interview notes and statements of witnesses 1, 3, 7, 8, 12, 13 and 14, which the

Prosecution requested to protect third innocent parties, the identities of OTP and

VWU personnel present during the interviews of such witnesses, and the location of

the interviews;

DECIDE to grant the Prosecution an extension of 24 hours for the implementation of the First Decision on Redactions with the variations provided for in the present decision.
