- 1. The Trial Chamber is seised of a number of applications from the Office of the Prosecutor ("prosecution") in relation to disclosure: "Prosecution's Application for Lifting of Redactions, Non-Disclosure of Information and Disclosure of Summary Evidence" dated 12 December 2007;1 "Prosecution's Application for Non-Disclosure of Information on the Basis of Article 54(3)(f)" dated 13 December 2007;2 "Prosecution's Application for Lifting of Redactions and Non-Disclosure of Information" dated 14 December 2007;3 "Prosecution's Provision of Witness Statements and Request to Disclose Summary Evidence further to the "Prosecution's Request for Application for Lifting of Redactions and Non-Disclosure of Information" filed 12 December 2007" dated 19 "Prosecution's Application for Non-Disclosure of 2007;4 December Information on the Basis of Article 54(3)(f)" filed on 21 December 2007.5 The defence filed a response to the applications of 12, 13 and 14 December 2007 on 4 January 2008,6 and to the application of 21 December 2007 on 10 January 2008.7
- 2. The Trial Chamber heard oral submissions on the prosecution's applications at a public Status Conference on 10 January 2008.8 On the same day, the prosecution was heard on specific requests in the applications in an *ex parte* hearing.9 Further materials and information were requested from the
